The issues impacting our students are larger than any one school or neighborhood. Over 90% of educators surveyed stated that they believe that school climate and culture impacts both student achievement and student well-being and 81% said that they are hungry for training in social-emotional learning. Yet, only 1 in 25 schools have had trauma training and families and community organizations frequently do not have the opportunity to actively engage in supporting their school's climate and culture. We need to come together to share our struggles, as well as our resources and solutions.

E4E-Chicago and Chicago Public Schools are partnering to host Problem-Solving Forums that will continue bringing together knowledge, resources, and diverse perspectives from within and outside of schools to better equip educators to innovate, problem-solve, and meet the needs of all the students they teach.
