Raffle/Wristband sales:

Don’t want volunteers handling money at food stations (tickets only)

Make sure CC/Debit card is available

Add tiered pricing for tickets (ie. 10 for \$10, 25 for \$20, 60 for \$50, etc.)

Need to come up with rain contingency plan. No carnival rides/games or bouncy houses but could still set up Budlong generated games and food inside. If we do that, we could justify a non-refundable ticket if we have a good contingency.

Raffle: Fish bowl style, winner must be present. Raffle committee is meeting today after school to come up with approximately 10-15 packages to choose from.

Food:

Moving beyond hot dogs and pizza, looking at mini burritos & empanadas from Harvest Time.

Need volunteers to help with setting up food as well as manning the food stations.

Goal is to try and get better idea of how much is made and spent on food at this event.
